Traditionally, the time of Lent starting with the 5th Sunday until the Sacred Paschal Triduum (Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday) is known as "Passiontide". We are entering the proximate preparations for the Triduum. In the Gospels, as His Passion drew near, the Jews desired to put our Blessed Lord to death, but He "hid" Himself so that He would die when and how God's Providence had ordained. Therefore, we veil His image in the Church. Because He is veiled, so are those of His Angels and Saints. The effect is quite stark. We are deprived of the comfort of these images for two weeks, having already experienced a more sombre ornamentation of the Sanctuary since the beginning of Septuagesima and Lent. It will make the effect of the ornamentations for Easter more glorious, when the statues are unveiled, and flowers are introduced once more.

Tradicionalmente, el tiempo de Cuaresma que comienza con el V Domingo hasta el Triduum Pascual (Jueves, Viernes y Sábado Santo) se conoce como la temporada de la Pasión. Estamos entrando en los preparativos próximos al Triduum. En los Evangelios, al acercarse Su Pasión, los judíos deseaban dar muerte a nuestro Bendito Señor, pero Él se "escondió" para morir cuando y como la Providencia de Dios había dispuesto. Por eso, velamos Su imagen en la Iglesia. Porque Él está velado, también lo están las de Sus Ángeles y Santos. El efecto es bastante duro. Nos vemos privados del consuelo de estas imágenes durante dos semanas, habiendo experimentado ya una ornamentación más sombría del Santuario desde el comienzo de Septuagésima y de la Cuaresma. El efecto de la ornamentación de Pascua será más glorioso cuando se descubran las estatuas y se introduzcan de nuevo las flores.

If you are using candles in honor of Easter in your homes, please bring them to be blessed BEFORE Easter weekend and not for the Easter Masses.

Sunday Family Catechism: Lesson 22 (Sector II)

Answers from last week:

What had the Apostles hoped Jesus would do? The Apostles had hoped that Jesus would set up His great earthly kingdom at this feast.

What happened on Easter Sunday morning? On Sunday, Jesus rose by His own divine power.

What happened to Jesus' body and soul at the Resurrection? At the Resurrection His body and were reunited and glorified.

What were the qualities of His resurrected body? His body took on spiritual qualities: immortality, beauty and glory, freedom and the power to move about with speed and without hinderance.

Why is the Resurrection so important? The Resurrection is the strongest proof of Jesus' divinity.

¿Qué sucedió el domingo de Pascua por la mañana? El domingo, Jesús resucitó por su propio poder divino.

¿Qué sucedió con el cuerpo y el alma de Jesús en la resurrección? En la resurrección, su cuerpo y su alma se reunieron y fueron glorificados.

¿Cuáles eran las cualidades de su cuerpo resucitado? Su cuerpo adquirió cualidades espirituales: inmortalidad, belleza y gloria, libertad y el poder de moverse con rapidez y sin obstáculos.

¿Por qué es tan importante la resurrección? La resurrección es la prueba más contundente de la divinidad de Jesús.
