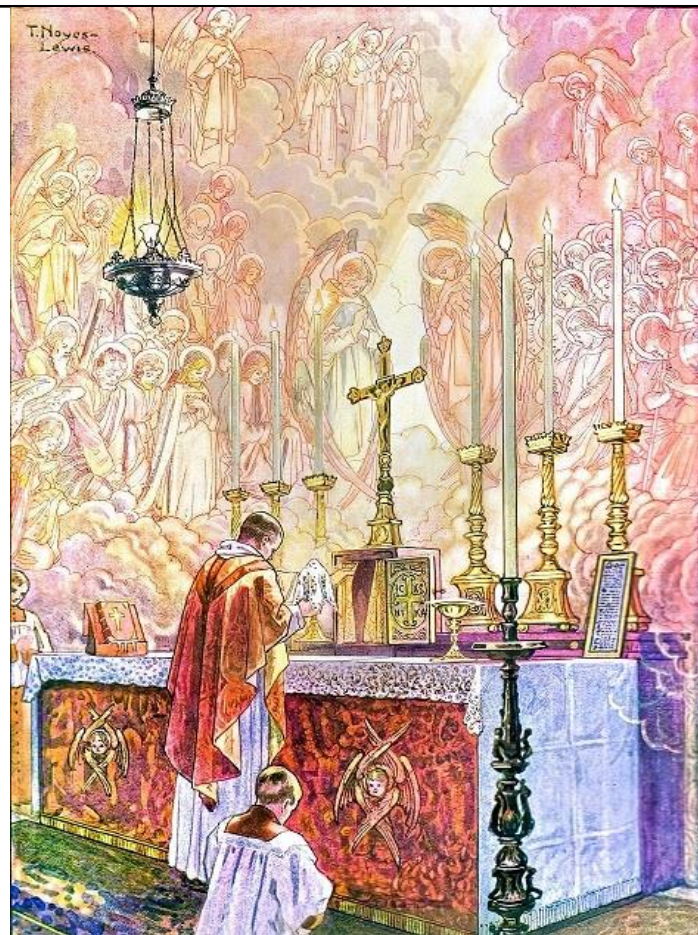

Week of April 19:

Sunday Family Catechism: Lesson 24 (Sector IV)

Answers from last week:

When did Jesus promise the Holy Spirit to the apostles? Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit at the Last Supper.

Who was with the apostles in the upper room? What were they doing? The Apostles were gathered in the upper room, with Mary His Mother and the other holy women. They spent their time praying.

How many days after the Ascension did the Holy Spirit descend on them? Ten days after the Ascension the Holy Spirit descended on them.

What did it look like when the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles and our Lady? The Holy Spirit appeared as tongues of fire on their heads.

How many people were baptized after Peter's first sermon? About three thousand people were baptized after Peter's first sermon.

What did the Apostles do after Pentecost? After Pentecost, the Apostles went out and preached. They performed many miracles and converted many people.

¿Cómo se veía cuando el Espíritu Santo descendió sobre los apóstoles y Nuestra Señora? El Espíritu Santo apareció como lenguas de fuego sobre sus cabezas.

¿Cuántas personas fueron bautizadas después del primer sermón de Pedro? Alrededor de tres mil personas fueron bautizadas después del primer sermón de Pedro.

¿Qué hicieron los apóstoles después de Pentecostés? Después de Pentecostés, los apóstoles salieron a predicar. Realizaron muchos milagros y convirtieron a mucha gente.

Bible Narrative 24. On **Pentecost**, which was 50 days after Easter, the **Holy Spirit** came down on the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Apostles, filling them with **courage** so that they could teach everyone how to follow Jesus. The Catholic Church does this work until now and will do it until the end of time.
